Strategic Governance

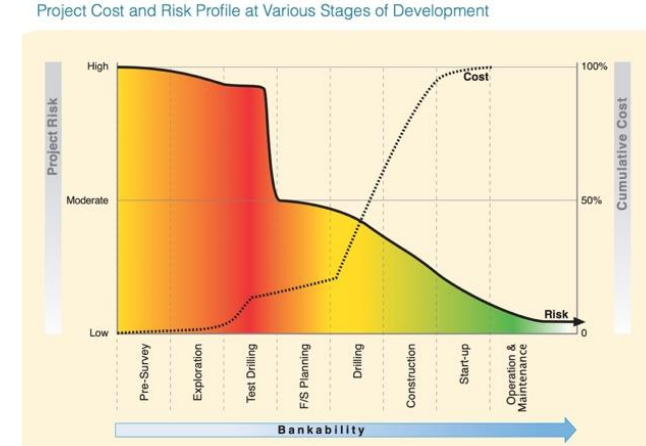
- Streamline consenting

- Recognition of Māori authority as land and resource owners

Māori Customary Interests

- Māori-led geothermal enterprise
- Access to water allocation (beyond First-in-First-Served)
- Enable participation– for geothermal and economic sustainability
- Vocational centre of learning for capability building

Access to Data

- Access to data for all users (national geothermal data repository)
- Māori authority over Māori geothermal data
